## AMVETS ANNOUNCE CHANGES TO THE JUNE WALNUT ANTIQUE SHOW



The AMVETS have decided to change the dates of the annual antique show held on Father's Day weekend. The show will not change its operation on Thursday, Friday or Saturday except that the show will officially end at 5 PM on Saturday. **There will be no show on Sunday.** The show has undergone changes many times during the last 37 years and this is another significant change. For the first time in 37 years, many Walnut folks who are major players in the conduct of one of the most significant antique shows in the country will have a chance to celebrate Father's Day instead of working at the show.

This change has been in the "making" for a number of years and will hopefully be an improvement. As before, the streets affected will be closed at 6 PM on Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup> and remain closed for the show until Saturday night, June 15<sup>th</sup>. The streets will remain closed to "thru" traffic until noon on Sunday to allow some clean-up and packing for some vendors that can't finish on Saturday night. Local folks should be able to get to and from their homes during this time.

The Walnut Fire Department has indicated that they will provide their excellent breakfast on Sunday as usual so local folks can enjoy that as they have every year.

## DOG LICENSES DUE

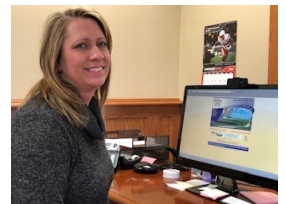
Yearly dog licenses are due February 14, 2019. If you live in the incorporated areas of Walnut and you own, keep or harbor one or more dogs 6 or more months of age, you are required to license them. Documents needed to purchase a new dog license or to renew include: license fee (\$8 spayed/neutered; \$22 intact), proof of current rabies vaccination for each dog, proof of spay/neuter (if applicable), and, if mailing, a self-addressed stamped envelope.
